

Suggests for Using this Worksheet

There are many ways to conduct this survey with your students and input the data online. These three suggestions are organized from least teacher involvement to more teacher involvement.

1. Have your students go to the survey on a computer in your classroom and answer each question personally.
 - a. The URL for the **individual survey** is:
http://drtimtyson.com/surveys/begin_school_year/survey.php
2. Or, the teacher could print out one copy of the survey questions (boy or girl as they are the same) and one copy of this EZ Data Worksheet.
 - a. As someone reads the questions aloud, the students answer each question by show of hands or on their own paper.
 - b. Count the number of yes and no responses for each question for the boys and for the girls separately: four answers for each question, two (yes/no) for the boys and two (yes/no) for the girls.
 - c. Record the information on this tally sheet. (Use a reliable student if you wish.)
 - d. Go to this URL, **which is different from the individual survey URL**, to quickly and easily input the results for **the entire class**:

3. Or, the teacher could print out enough copies of the two survey questions (boy or girl have the same questions but are labeled by sex to make tallying the results easier after they are handed in) and one copy of this EZ Data Worksheet.
 - a. Have the students answer the questions on their individual survey form and pass them in.
 - b. Divide the completed surveys into two stacks: Boys and Girls.
 - c. Using this form, tally the number of yes and no responses for each question for the boys and the girls separately. (Use a reliable student if you wish.)
 - d. Go to this URL, **which is different from the individual survey URL**, to quickly and easily input the results for the entire class:
